November 21, 2016

**Call to order** - The meeting opened with Pastor Neumann leading us in a short devotion reviewing Faith's Constitution Article VIII - Article XII.

**Elder's report** - Membership changes – Transfer of Allison Hood (Everly), and Mitchell Volk to Christ Lutheran Church, North St. Paul

**Pastor's report** - Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary Choir will be here on Ash Wednesday, March 1, 2017. After discussion among the council it was moved and supported to hold that service at our Black River Falls location at 6:30 p.m. and have only one joint service that night.

There will be need for members of the congregation to house members of the Choir and assist with a meal prior to the church service.


## **LADIES AID**
