Jesus is My Savior from Satan

The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work. - 1 John 3:8

Is the devil real? He doesn't really exist, right? WRONG! The devil is a fallen angel. He is called Satan, which means "adversary." He has one goal. He wants to literally "give you hell." Picture him as a prosecutor standing before the judgment seat of God. He talks about your character flaws like pride, anger, and your evil desires of greed and lust. He's very convincing. And that "father of lies" is not lying. You can't deny what he says about you. It appears his case work will bring about an eternal sentence of hell for you.

But wait, Satan doesn't have the last word. Jesus Christ has come to our defense. He set out to defeat the devil and put an end to his evil work. Jesus came to earth not to just hinder, slow down or frustrate the devil and his dealings with you. He came to destroy him. That is exactly what Jesus did by his death on the cross. Jesus' death on the cross in your place is the devil's destruction. All of the devil's accusation about you before God are stopped because on the cross Jesus won the forgiveness for all of your sins. The devil can no longer successfully accuse you before God. So what does the devil do now if he can't speak to God about your sins? He speaks to you! The devil comes to you reminding you of your sins and tries to convince you that God won't forgive you. This is his last resort. He tries day and night to tempt you to sin and then push you to despair over your condition.

But the victory is already won! The victory belongs to Jesus and by faith it belongs to you. Resist the devil's temptations and he will flee from you. He may try to set snares, but you aren't ignorant of his devices. You have the shield of faith in Jesus that extinguishes all the fiery darts of that wicked one.

So keep your eyes on Jesus, who died for you, and your enemy the devil can't have his wicked way with you. The truth is that the devil's evil work has been destroyed by the Son of God, Jesus Christ. He is your Savior from Satan.

Special Reports:


- 1. Jesus Cares Ministries will resume classes Sept 26, 2016 and review PR efforts.
- 2. Outreach a written report was presented by Rudy Jeseritz that highlighted the fact that Faith will be sponsoring a concert in the park event by Koine on Tuesday, July 25, 2017 at the Lunda Park in Black River Falls.

Old Business

- 1. Christian Education Funding was discussed and Scott Templeton presented the Church Council's recommendation and gave an example for those attending.
- o Budgeted amount for funding Christian Education will be based on 8% of the envelope and plate offerings received from the previous year.
- Funding will be for any WELS Elementary School, WELS High Schools, WELS Prep School, Martin Luther College and WELS Seminary
- o 100% of our Pastor's children's grade school (PreK-8th Grade) tuition will be paid from the total.
- o The remaining amount will be divided equally among any other students.
- o Any unused funds will be returned to the budget and not carried over to the next year.
- The Congregation reserves the right to amend this policy due to unknown budget constraints or other circumstances that may arise.
- o This policy will take effect on Jan. 1, 2017 for the end of the 2017 school year and beginning of the 2018 school year.
 - MSC to follow the recommendation as printed and for policy to be reviewed annually and for the Council / Congregation to reserve the right to amend the policy.

New Business:

PREPARING YOUR CHILD FOR CONFIRMATION CONTINUED...

Last month we asked the question, "Does confirmation still have value today?" As we answered there we answer here – YES. But why are so many of our confirmands in our Wisconsin Synod churches not coming back to church after their confirmations? I pray that taking to heart these points will help stem the tide.

- Remember that children's self-esteem is fragile. When they come home crushed by verbal stones thrown by friends, use the same truths which they are learning in confirmation class to comfort them. Show them that what they are learning is relevant.
- Give your children an opportunity to tell you what they are gaining from their instruction. Challenge them to see ways they can serve Christ and his church before and after confirmation.
- Point out the real importance of confirmation day. It is much more than one way to get Uncle Harold and Aunt Hilda to drive up from Florida. This is the day they stand before God and his witnesses to confess their faith and to promise their loyalty to Jesus.
- Realize that a parent's job is not over with confirmation. Remember the worth of a picture. Your children will still be watching your example. What will you show them about the value you place on Christ and your own ministry in his name?
- Realize that just being confirmed doesn't mean being grown up. Remember that when your children are confirmed, it doesn't mean they have matured to the point of always making wise decisions. They are still very emotional. They still need you to curb their sinful flesh. They will more often than not make the wrong decision if you allow them to decide if they should or shouldn't go to church. You are still their parents.


The Ladies Aid of Cataract will resume their monthly meetings on Thursday, September 8 at 12:30 p.m.
